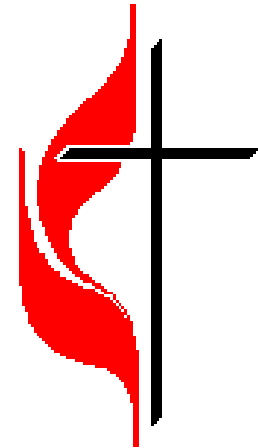

Two Ways To Make Planned Gifts ...

If you wish to make a *loving gift* to our Church in your name or in that of a loved one, there are two ways of giving available to you:

1. Advisory Fund -- Both the full amount of your gift and the income earned on that gift will be used to support the ministry of your choice.

2. Endowment Fund -- Your gift is held in permanence, with only the income earned on that gift being used to support the ministry of your choice.



.....to support these missions & ministries...

- ❑ **Education Fund**
provides financial assistance to Church members (1) who were active in the Church as senior high school youth for study at an accredited college or university; (2) for study at an accredited theological seminary; (3) for church leadership programs.
- ❑ **Mission Fund**
supports programs which minister to the local community through the Church; supports participation in mission projects (domestic or international) which typically require travel in excess of 100 miles.
- ❑ **Children and Youth Fund**
supports faith-related programs for children and youth within the congregation, as well as for reaching out to the local community.
- ❑ **Worship Fund**
supports special worship and music activities which are distinct from our customary worship and which may reach out to the local community.
- ❑ **Capital Improvement Fund**
supports major improvements to the physical facilities and grounds of the Church or the purchase of equipment or furnishings for the Church.
- ❑ **General Fund**
undesignated gifts which support (1) other mission projects of a non-recurring nature that benefit the Church; (2) work which is primarily financed by another fund.

The Committee on Planned Giving provides assistance with gifting to Fairwood Community United Methodist Church. The Committee also manages gifted assets until they are used for their designated purposes.

A gift may be given to support a specific, pre-defined mission or ministry as shown on the left. A gift may also be given to the General Fund, in which case the Committee will fund worthy projects which advance the mission and ministries of the Church.

The Planned Giving Committee evaluates requests and proposed projects for funding which are submitted by individuals or groups within the Church.
